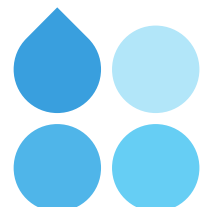
- Review and evaluation of manufacturing documentation for pharmaceutical active ingredients, intermediates and contract-manufactured finished products such as capsules
